

RECIPE OF THE WEEK APPLE CRISP

medium size apples

l/4 cup granulated sugar

Cinnamon

1/4 cup butter 1/2 cup flour

3/4 cup brown sugar

Peel the apples and slice into a buttered baking dish. Sprinkle with the granulated sugar and cinnamon. Combine the butter, flour and brown sugar, and spread mixture on top of apples. Bake about 30 minutes in a moderate oven (350 deg. F.) until apples are soft and top is golden brown. Serves 6.
