



## RECIPE OF THE WEEK BANANA CAKE

2-1/2 cups sifted cake flour
2-1/2 teaspoons Baking Powder
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup all-purpose oil
1-1/4 cups mashed ripe bananas
2 eggs
1/2 cup milk

Sift together flour, baking powder, and salt. Add oil, bananas, and milk. Beat until the mixture forms a very stiff batter. In a separate bowl, beat eggs until thick and foamy. Gradually add sugar and beat until very well blended. Fold egg-sugar mixture into first batter. Pour into 2 greased and floured 9 x 1-1/2 inch round layer cake pans. Bake in a 375°F. (mod-erate) oven about 30 minutes. Cool before frosting and frost with Seven Minute Frosting and walnut meats.
