RECIPE OF THE WEEK
DEVILED-EGG CASSEROLE

Bake at 350 deg. F about 20 minutes. Makes 6 servings.

- 6 hard-cooked eggs, shelled
- 5 tablespoons mayonnaise or salad dressing
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon prepared mustard
- $\frac{1}{8}$ teaspoon pepper
- 2 cans (8 ounces each) tomatoe sauce
- 1 cup water
- 1cup grated process American cheese
- 1 tablespoon grated onion
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- $\frac{1}{8}$ teaspoon oregano
- 4 cups drained cooked elbow macaroni (1 eight-ounce package, uncooked)
- 1 can (about $3\frac{1}{4}$ ounces)sardines

1. Halve eggs lengthwise; remove yolks; put through coarse sieve into bowl; blend in mayonnaise or salad dressing, salt, mustard, and pepper; pile into white halves.
2. Combine tomato sauce, water, $\frac{3}{4}$ cup cheese, onion, Worcestershire sauce, and oregano in saucepan; cook over low heat until cheese melts; combine with macaroni in bowl.
3. Pour into baking dish, sprinkle with remaining $\frac{1}{4}$ cup cheese; arrange deviled eggs and sardines on top; cover loosely with aluminum foil.
4. Bake in moderate oven (350 deg.F) 20 minutes, or until heated through; remove foil; serve hot.
