GET YOUR BUSH TRAVEL PERMIT (Cont.)

the Department in other years, forest travel permits are not necessary for travel along main highways or secondary roads or for travelling between city or town and summer cottage. Travellers must have permits, however, for entering forested areas off main highways, or for any canoe trips.

In obtaining a permit, the traveller must give information as to destination, routes and duration of trip. Such information not only will aid the Department in establishing responsibility for any fires in areas travelled but also serve as protection for the traveller. Many occasions are on record where Department personnel were able to reach fishing and camping parties through permit information when their safety was threatened or when emergency at home made it imperative that they be reached without delay.
