RECIPE OF THE WEEKSTRAWBERRY CHIFFON PIE

1 package strawberry-flavoured gelatine  
 1 cup hot water  
 1 cup crushed sweetened strawberries, fresh or frozen  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  cup sugar  
 2 stiff-beaten egg whites  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup heavy cream, whipped  
 1-9 inch baked pastry shell

Dissolve gelatine in hot water. Chill until partially set. Beat fluffy. Fold in berries. Gradually beat sugar into egg whites; beat until mixture stands in peaks and sugar is dissolved. Fold egg whites and cream into gelatine mixture. Pour into cooled baked pastry shell. Chill until set. Top with whipped cream. Garnish with sliced strawberries. Serves 6.
