### SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM STARTED JULY 2ND

Some of the older girls shared their first craft session, while others took part in softball under the surveillance of Gayle. They worked at spatter painting, colouring, pasting and lino blocks.

Once again in the afternoon the beach was a scene of swimming lessons for the seniors and water games for the younger sets.

### IMPROVEMENTS

This year the beach area will be put to better use with the addition of trick bars, separate horse-shoe pits for adults and children. The children in the pool are under careful instruction of Jim Fraser and lifeguard Marvin Steen.

In the mornings the playground is conducted at the Centre, and at the beach area in the afternoons. The pool is open from 12:00 noon until 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday, and from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. The bus leaves the Recreation Centre at 1:15 p.m. and the Dam at 4:00 p.m.

As an extra pastime, the staff has selected an archery set and dart game for the children.
