WHEN YOU TRAVEL YOUR BLUE CROSS HOSPITAL PLAN TRAVELSWITH YOU (Cont.)

When you are admitted to a Blue Cross member hospital anywhere in Canada or United States show your Blue Cross certificate to the Admitting Officer. Hospitals which participate in the BANK will notify their local Blue Cross Plans which will in turn contact the Ont. Plan for the number of days hospitalization available to you. Meantime, your one concern is to get well again.

Within a day or two after you are admitted, the hospital will be advised as to the number of days care you may receive and you will be entitled to the regular benefits of the Blue Cross Plan serving that hospital.
