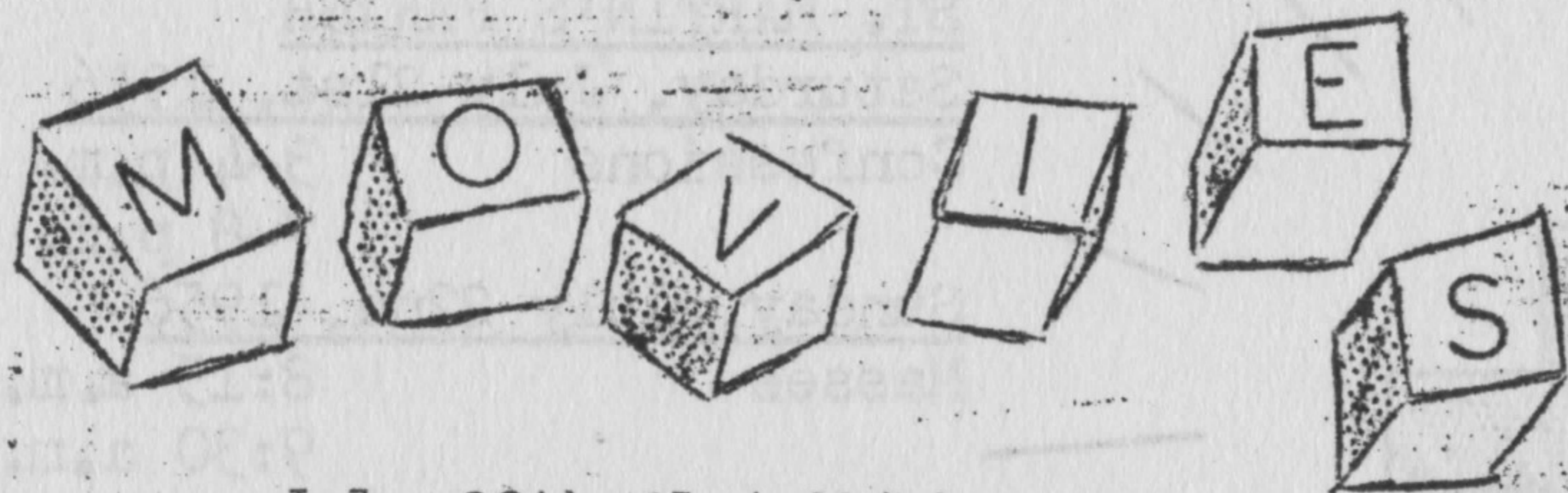


RECREATION FLYER (Cont.)
