RECIPE OF THE WEEK
CHILI CON CARNE

- 1 large onion, sliced
 - 1 green pepper, chopped
 - 1 pound ground beef
 - 3 tablespoons fat
 - 1 Can (3-1/2 cups) tomatoes
 - 1-1/2 teaspoons salt
 - 1/8 teaspoon paprika
 - 1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper
 - 3 whole cloves
 - 1 bay leaf
 - 1 to 2 tablespoons chili powder
 - 1 can (2-1/2 cups) kidney beans
- Cook onion, pepper, and meat in hot fat until onion is golden. Add tomatoes and seasonings. Simmer 2 hours. Add beans; heat thoroughly.
