

RECIPE OF THE WEEK COUNTRY GARDEN SALAD

THE RESERVE OF THE PARTY OF THE

cups mixed salad greens, broken into bite-size pleces

can (7 ounces) tuna, drained and flaked

head lettuce, washed and separated into leaves

tomatoes, sliced and halved

large mushrooms, thinly sliced

small cucumber, sliced

hard-cooked egg yolks, sieved Green onions Carrot sticks
Garlic French Dressing

Combine salad greens and tuna in large bowl; line rim of bowl with lettuce leaves.

Arrange tomatoes, mushrooms, and cucumber; fill center with egg yolk; poke in green onions and carrot sticks.

When ready to serve, toss lightly with Garlic French Dressing.

Garlic French Dressing

Combine in screw-top jar 2/3 cup salad oil; 1/4 cup vinegar; 3 tablespoons catsup; 2 teaspoons lemon juice; 1/8 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce; 1 clove of garlic, sliced; 1/2 teaspoon salt; 1/8 teaspoon dry mustard; and a dash of pepper. Cover; shake well. Makes 1 cup dressing.
