OPEN SEASON: MOOSE, DEER AND MIGATORY BIRDS

In crecent issues of the Terrace Bay News incorrect information was printed regarding open season for Moose and Deer. James Scott, Conservation Officer, Dept. of Lands and Forests has supplied us with the following correct information on the open seasons. Non-resident Hunters.

Open Season for Deer in the Geraldton <u>Forestry District:</u> North of the northern most C.N.R. line:-

October 1 - November 26th Remainder of District:- October 22-November 26th.

Ruffed Grouse, Sharp Tailed Grouse, Spruce Partridge - Sept. 29th-Nov. 26th-Inclusive No open season for Hungarian Partridge.

Open seasons for Ducks, Geese, Rails, Coots, Gallinules, Woodcock and Wilson's Snipe Northern District - Noon Sept, 15th-Dec. 15th.

Open Season for Moose in the Geraldton <u>Forestry District:</u> North of Highway 11:-October 1-December 24- any Moose - Resident (Cont. on next col.) Central District - Noon Sept. 29th-Dec. 15th.

Southern District - Noon Oct. 6th-Dec. 15th.

NOTE: That part of the Geraldton District lying north of the northern most line of the C.N.R. is in the Northern District and the remainder of the Geraldton District lies within the Central District.
