

TOWNSITE LANDSCAPING

LongLac Pulp and Paper Company Ltd. will deliver top-soil to townsite residents at the rate of \$4.00 per load (approx. 5 cu. yd.) Delivery will begin October 3rd. Anyone desiring material should fill out the form at the bottom of the page and return it to the townsite office as soon as possible. No phone calls will be accepted.

A sample of this material was sent to the Ontario Agricultural College, Department of Soils Advisory Service and they recommended the following procedure be used for seeding a lawn.

"I presume this top dressing is to go on a sandy area. I suggest that area to be top dressed is levelled off before top dressing is applied. Before applying top dressing apply a 4-24-12 fertilizer at 25 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of area and then harrow or rake lightly. Follow this with at least 2 - 3 inches of top dressing. Apply 4-12-10 fertilizer at 10-15 lbs. per acre to this top soil. When levelled off, rake in the fertilizer well, rake both ways. Sow following grass seed mixture: 1-1/2 lbs. Kentucky Blue grass, 1 lb. Creeping Red Fescue, 1/2 lbs. Red Top, 1/2 lb. Perennial Rye Grass, 1/2 lbs. Crested Wheat Grass = 4 lbs. mixture per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn area. Try to get grass seed sown evenly over area, roll after seeding, and then water it well with a fine spray so as not to disturb grass seed."

This method is similar to that used by the Townsite Department (re Lakeview, Kenogami) with the exception that both lime and fertilizer are used in one application preferably one week or more previous to seeding. The above seed mixture is available at the warehouse at 0.53¢/lb.
