RECIPE OF THE WEEK

STUFFED ONIONS

- 6 large Bermuda onions
- 1/2 pound ground beef
- 1/4 pound sausage
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 2 tablespoons chopped onion centers
- 2 tablespoons water

Cook onions in boiling, salted water 30 minutes. Drain and cool. Cut from top half way through onions; remove centers. Combine remaining ingredients. Stuff onions; place onions in muffin pans. Bake in moderate oven (350°) 30 minutes. Serves 6.
