Me Papoose Sitter - Gordon Langley Hall

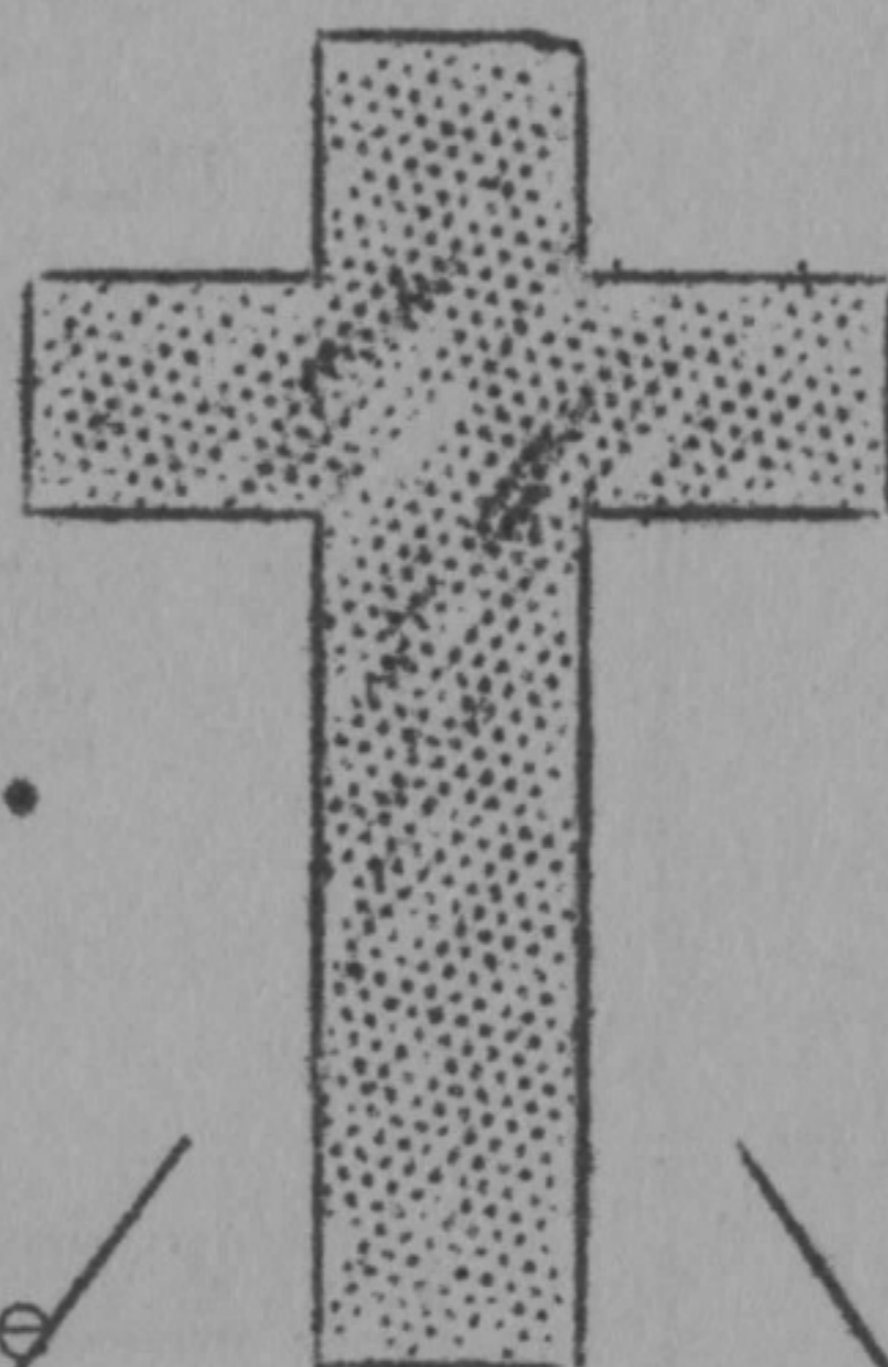
