RECIPE OF THE WEEKPeanut Whirligigs

2 cups sifted all purpose flour
1/2 tsp. salt
1/2 cup butter or margarine
1/2 cup shortening
1 3-oz. pkg. cream cheese
1 cup white sugar
1 tsp. vanilla
3/4 cup semisweet-chocolate pieces,
melted
2 tbsps. melted butter
3/4 cup ground salted peanuts
Sift together flour and salt. Mix butter and next 4 ingredients until creamy. Mix in flour mixture, peanuts. Chill until easy to handle. Heat oven to 400 degrees. On lightly floured board roll half of dough into 1/8" thick rectangle. Mix chocolate, melted butter; spread half over rolled dough. Roll up like jelly roll. Repeat with rest of dough. With sharp knife slice 1/8" thick. Bake about 8 to 10 Min. Yield about 8 doz.
