In all kinds of weather and winter road conditions, teams travelled approximately 12,433 miles in their meeting each other three times on their home ice. Last season to complete their schedule approximately 8,311 miles were covered by the five teams in the League. This past season's record of 12,433 miles - a distance compared to a little better than three times the breadth of Canada from coast to coast (3986.8 miles) - were covered by the six teams to complete their 88-game schedule. Red Rock Royals were unable to use their arena until January 31st, and because of this, were forced to travel to the Nipigon Memorial Arena for their home games. This reporter believes that no other Intermediate League has travelled as extensively as the Member Clubs of the North Shore Hockey League, and if this belief be untrue, it is left to be repudiated by Frank Walters, Intermediate Convenor of the Thunder Bay Amateur Hockey Association.

ATTENDANCE FIGURES SHOW DROP IN
NORTH SHORE HOCKEY LEAGUE

Attendance at the 88 games of the 90-game schedule of the North Shore Hockey League was down compared to the all-time record established last season in its 60-game schedule - 12 home games for each of the five teams. Because of Geraldton Goldminers' unreadiness to play their first two games, 88 games of the schedule were played - 13 home games for the Goldminers, and 15 each for Red Rock Royals, Nipigon Flyers, Schreiber Colts, Terrace Bay Superiors and Marathon Mercuries.

Despite the fact that the League this past season boasted one more team plus an increase of 28 games, there was a total of 34,279 paid admissions compared to the record of 36,567 - an average of 389 compared to 609 per game. A total of \$15,062.85 was collected from these admissions compared to \$16,486.30 last season.

With Red Rock Royals as the new entry in the League, attendances on teams' home ice were as follows:
