## ATTENDANCE FIGURES SHOW DROP IN NORTH SHORE HOCKEY LEAGUE

Attendance at the 88 games of the 90game schedule of the North Shore Hockey League was down compared to the all-time record established last season in its 60game schedule - 12 home games for each of the five teams. Because of Geraldton Goldminers: unreadiness to play their first two games, 38 games of the schedule were played - 13 home games for the Goldminers, and 15 each for Red Rock Royals, Nipigon Flyers, Schreiber Colts, Terrace Bay Superiors and Marathon Mercuries. Despite the fact that the League this past season boasted one more team plus an increase of 28 games, there was a total of 34,279 paid admissions compared to the record of 36,567 - an average of 389 compared to 609 per game. A total of \$15,062,85 was collected from these admissions compared to \$16,486.30 last season.
