ANSWER: The Ontario Pulp and Paper Makers' Safety Association
- QUESTION: On what basis was the Safety Contest we won in 1956 Budget?  
ANSWER: Limited Severity
- QUESTION: What does the term "Limited Severity" mean?  
ANSWER: It's simply the number of days lost due to on-the-job injuries per thousand man hours worked, with a limit of 26 days.
