



RECIPE OF THE WEEK

GRAHAM CRACKER CAKE -

2 c. butter or vegetable shortening
1 c. sugar
3 eggs, beaten separately
3/4 c. milk
26 graham crackers, rolled fine, used as flour,
1 tsp. baking powder - add to cracker crumbs
2 tsp. vanilla
pinch of salt.

Cream shortening and sugar. Add milk and egg yolks, well beaten. Add graham cracker crumbs, etc., Fold in stiffly beaten egg whites last. If desired, ½ c. of walnuts may be added. Bake about 30 minutes in moderate oven.
