

The Recreation Association has allotted \$75 to the T.B.A.B.A. This money will be used for much needed field improvements. Two sets of permanent base pegs will be installed; backstop will be extended vertically by an additional 10 feet; the field will be surveyed and properly aligned; and the infield will be revamped. This last job will consist of dumping about 10 loads of clay on the infield, raking it out, and then rolling it down to give a smooth and stone-free playing surface.

Four teams make up the Softball League as it now stands. Murdo Campbell, Frank Whitfield, Ed Pineault, and Bill Kurylo have been appointed temporary managers in order to organize these teams.
