supplied.

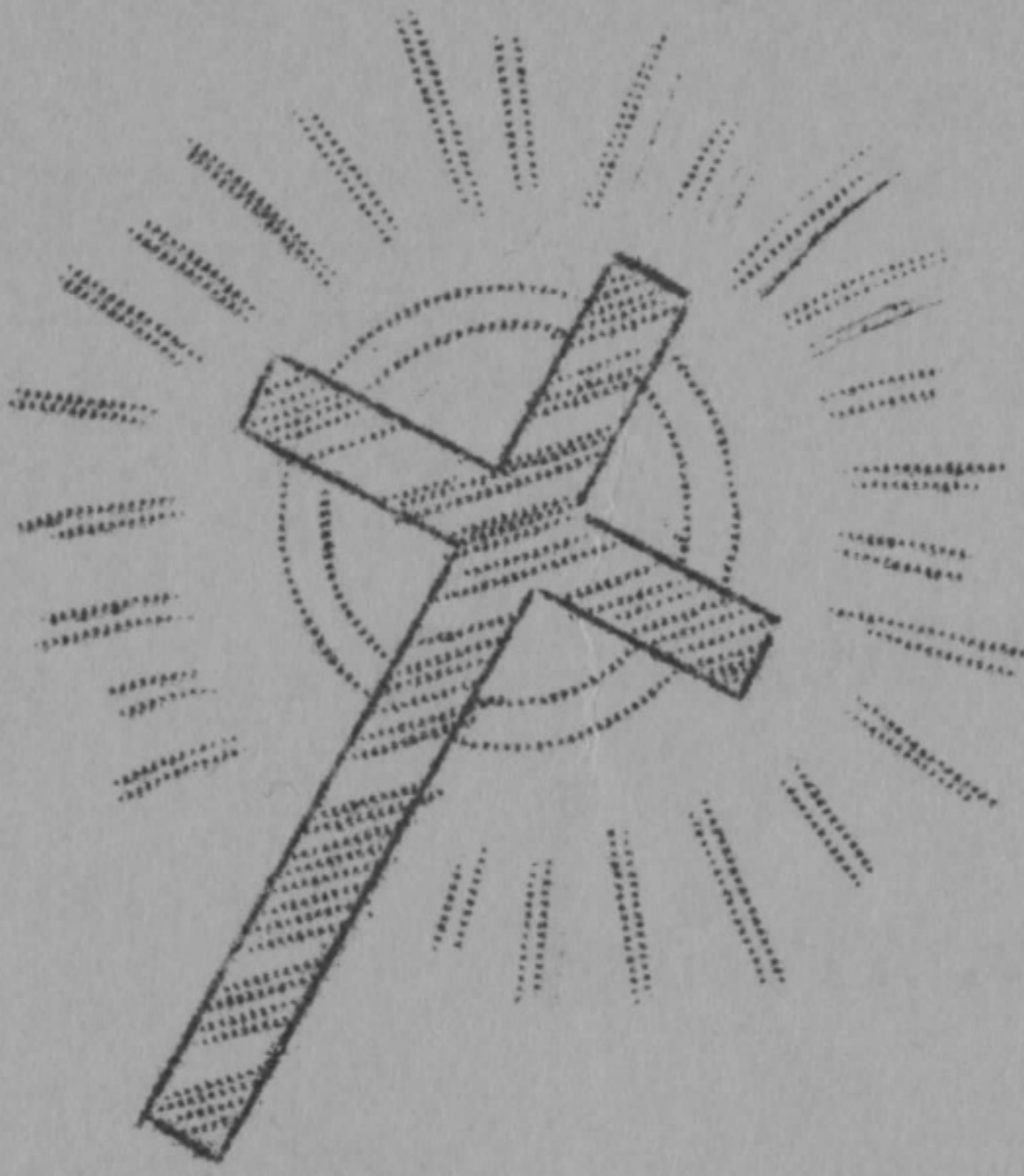
Mothers welcome - Come and join in
