CENOTAPH MEMORIAL cont'd from p. 2

A request has gone forward to the Terrace Bay Recreation Committee for official approval to place the Cenotaph on the landscaped area to the west of our beautiful Memorial Centre. An added reason for the Committee's choice of this location is the extreme possibility that at a future date (perhaps at time of Dedication) the Cenotaph may be turned over to the Recreation Committee for permanent maintenance, continual landscaping and watchful guardianship.....

- Since the foregoing write-up was prepared three important and welcome announcements may now be made. First, pledged contributions to the Cenotaph Fund have now reached the \$700 mark, a figure which is considered to be enough to cover "known" expenditures for this project. Secondly, Capt. J.L. Jeanneret, Officer Commanding, "D" Company, L.S.S.R., (Motor) has advised that the local Army unit will provide much of the needed voluntary labour for foundation installation. And finally, the Terrace Bay Recreation Committee has granted official approval to erect the Cenotaph on the spacious landscaped area of the Recreation Centre.

Certainly the progress made to date is impressive. It typifies the overall community spirit that prevails locally, without which no undertaking may be completed satisfactorily, and which is so essential in this particular endeavour.
