15 - 3 TO SWEEP SERIES

In the second game of the best of 3 series Salary whipped TeenTown by a 7-4 count to take the series in 2 straight games and as a result advance to the finals against Shift 2-Maintenance.

In the 2nd game of their set, Shift 2-Mtce. walloped Shift 3-4 by a 15-3 count to take the series in 2 straight games and advance to the finals.

Making the most of the few hits they managed and capitalizing on Teen Town errors Salary took an early lead and then coasted to the victory. On the other hand, Teen Town could not come up with a hit when they needed it as they left the bases loaded on 2 occasions with a total of 10 men being left on.

Shift 2-Maintenance started off early to show they meant business as they counted 8 big runs in the 2nd on but 4 hits. Shoddy playing by Shift 3-4 in the field resulted in the majority of these runs.

Salary opened the scoring in the 1st as Rundle singled in a run. Teen Town made a great bid in the bottom of the 1st when they loaded the bases with 1 out after Adamo had singled a run in. However a double play cut them off. Salary then scored 3 in the 3rd on 1 hit, 3 errors and a walk and added 3 more in the 5th on 1 hit, 2 errors and 3 walks to make the score 7-1. Teen Town rallied in the 6th for 3 runs on 3 hits, 2 errors and a walk to narrow the count to 7-4 but could manage nothing more.

A grand-slam homer by Marvin Osmar in the 3rd served to put the game away out of Shift 3-4's reach. An error in the 3rd brought Shift 3-4 their 1st run and made the score 12-1.

Salary were again led by Ken Ward with 2 hits and he also turned in a solid game in centerfield. Chopty on the mound turned in another steady game and managed to work out of a couple of tough spots with the aid of his fielders.

A double by Pluta in the 5th scored 2 more runs for Maintenance and upped the count to 14-1. However, an error and a walk brought Shift 3-4 2 runs in the 5th but fool-hardy base running cut off their attempts for a big rally. A single run by Maintenance in the 6th ended the scoring and made the final count 15-3 in Maintenance's favor.

For Teen Town, Adamo and Thompson tried their utmost as they each banged out 2 hits, LeBlanc who took over from Thompson on the mound turned in a neat relief stint but the damage had already been done.

For Maintenance, Marvin Osmar had a sensational game as he pounded out 4 hits including a homer and a double and collected 5 R.B.I.'s. In the field he performed well as he made some beautiful fielding plays at shortstop. Dejonghe also helped pace the attack with his 3 hits while Jim Moro and Cliff Wood also checked in with 2 hits apiece. Stan Zwaresh on the mound again turned in a good effort as he scattered 7 hits for the win.
