From Austria:

RICE VIENNESE STYLE

Ingredients:

- Butter 2 cups consomme, hot
- 1 small onion, chopped fine 1 cup canned peas, heated
- 1 cup rice 1 teaspoon
- salt and pepper paprika

* Can be frozen - In $\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoon butter, brown onion lightly, then add rice and cook until glazed. Salt and pepper. Add consomme, bring to a boil, let simmer on low heat until rice is done. (Consomme should be entirely absorbed.) With a fork, carefully stir peas through rice. Add $\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoons butter and sprinkle with paprika. Makes 4 to 5 servings.

*Note: If frozen, let thaw and reheat, or heat unthawed in covered double boiler; stir several times with fork.
