RECIPE OF THE WEEK

CANDIED APPLES

Ingredients: 2 cups sugar
1 cup water
1/4 tsp. Cream of Tartar, or
2/3 cup Light Corn Syrup.

Method: Stir over a slow heat until the sugar is dissolved, then cook quickly without stirring until the hard crack stage - 290°. Remove the pot containing syrup and plunge into very cold water just for a minute to check boiling then place over hot water to keep from hardening. Add a few drops of food colouring. Dip apples which you have placed on skewers in the syrup and place on a well-greased surface to harden.
