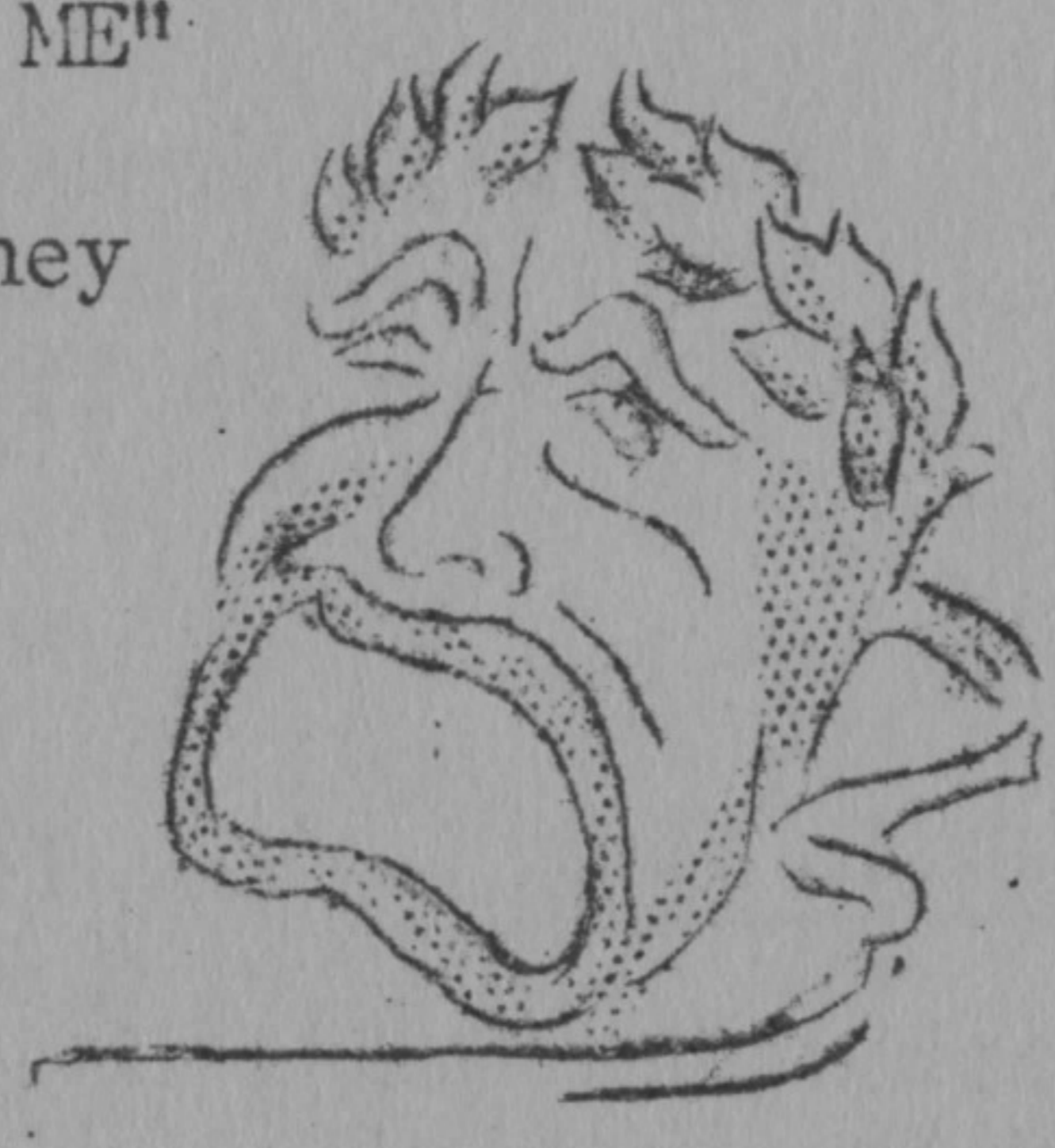

## Home Fire Protection

### Electrical Equipment & Circuits --

Fires of electrical origin are frequent. Some electrical fires start behind partitions or in other unseen places and may remain unnoticed until well under way. The cure for this hazard is proper wiring.

People are buying more electrical appliances today than ever before. In many cases, particularly where more than one family is living in a house overloading of circuits may be a real hazard. If you frequently "blow a fuse" when you turn on an appliance, your electrical "watchman" (the fuse) is trying to tell you "the circuit is overloaded". Heed this warning.

But -- don't put in a larger capacity fuse (Most household circuits should not have over 15 ampere fuses).

Numerous hazardous conditions are caused by "do it yourself" electrical installations. Other hazards result from failure to keep

electrical equipment and wiring in repair. Neglect of electrical equipment can only be false economy, especially if fire destroys your home. Play safe -- have the job done right now by a qualified electrician.

Frayed and deteriorating cords are sources of danger. Wires strung under rugs not only wear out the rugs more quickly but are a potential source of fire because of possible abrasion and failure of wiring insulation.

T.V. cabinets are purposely designed to allow for adequate ventilation. For this reason, you should not recess your T.V. set in a wall or homemade cabinet unless adequate ventilation is available. Outside T.V. antennas should be properly grounded to protect against lightning damage. The antenna should be adequately supported and installed so that it cannot fall across power lines in a wind storm or damage your chimney and cause a fire.

Don't forget the electric iron and other electrical heating appliances. Disconnect them when you have finished using them. Many adults as well as children have carelessly caused destructive fires because irons were left unattended in contact with combustible materials.

A comparatively new fire hazard in homes is the Automatic Clothes Dryer. Lint screens should be cleaned out at least once a week. Accumulated lint could cause a fire.
