Thirty members and twenty-five visitors were present at the meeting, Oct. 26th, which took the form of a Dinner at Hotel Terrace. Out-of-town guests included four from Marathon and two from Schreiber.

Presentation of the Annual Report revealed an increase in shares amounting to \$10,115.70 over last year's figure; and a 4% dividend was allotted.

Know Your Credit Union! - Commencing a series of questions and answers about Credit Unions, one of which will be published each week.

Q. How is my loan insured?

A. Our credit union has a contract for Loan Protection insurance with CUNA MUTUAL, the Credit Union Insurance Company. The life of each eligible borrower is insured in the amount of his loan balance . . . up to \$10,000. Here's a good example of loan protection at work: Let's suppose that today I borrowed \$300 to buy a refrigerator . . . and that tomorrow I became disabled or died. My loan would be paid for me, with interest as provided in the insurance contract.
