- COCONUT SPICE COOKIES

- 1/2 cup soft shortening,
- 1/4 teasp. cinnamon
- 1/2 teasp. ginger
- 1/4 teasp. nutmeg
- 1/4 teasp. allspice
- 2 tbsp. honey
- 1 pkg. white or silver cake mix,
- 3/4 cup shredded coconut, snipped.

Heat oven. Mix shortening with next 5 ingredients until creamy. Then using spoon pastry blender, or fingers, work in white-cake mix and coconut until firm, pastrylike dough is formed. Shape dough into small balls, using about 1 teasp. for each. Place on ungreased cookie sheet, 3" apart. Then, with fork or with bottom of tumbler dipped in sugar, press each ball flat.

When done leave to cool a few minutes before removing from cookie sheet.

Temp.: 375° Time: 8 min. Yield: 7 doz.
