MINOR HOCKEY AUXILIARY FORMED

Following the lead of several interested mothers, the ladies of Terrace Bay have formed an Auxiliary to Minor Hockey.

Purpose of the Auxiliary is to work in conjunction with the Minor Hockey Executive in raising funds, helping with banquets, and creating a closer contact between parents, players and the Hockey Executive.

Groups of this type are becoming more common and more important in the growth of Minor Hockey throughout Canada. In Terrace Bay, as in many Canadian towns, finances must be raised for minor hockey through donations and fund-raising campaigns. It is virtually impossible for an executive of 5 men to raise these funds without outside help.

It is also impossible to finance a minor hockey programme on gate receipts. Last year's gate receipts for minor hockey in Terrace Bay came to only \$78.00. Expected expenditures for minor hockey this year will be in the neighbourhood of \$700.00. For this reason, it is necessary to solicit for donations and other outside help.

Happily, many of our local organizations such as the Recreation Association, Kiwanis, Loyal Order of Moose, Women of the Moose, and Local 665, have very kindly donated to Minor Hockey. However, there is still a fair gap between what has been collected and what is needed. This is where the Ladies' Auxiliary will be of valuable help.
