There was once a member who was always borrowing and never seemed to save any money in the credit union. One day when he came in for a new loan, the treasurer asked him about it and suggested that he try to save a little. "It does not work for me" the member said. "Whenever I know I have cash in the credit union, I get restless until I have spent it. But I've found another way to save. I keep borrowing money, and buying land with it. I like land. I never want to sell it. I rent it to farmers, and at this point I have quite a big savings program."

Here are some of the advantages of doing all your borrowing in the Credit Union: -

1. You have only one bill to pay each month.
2. Your credit union has loan protection insurance. All your debts may be covered.
3. If it is necessary to re-finance or get a new loan it can be done without necessarily increasing your monthly payments.
4. If you are sick or laid off you won't be worried by mobs of creditors.
