

# Recipe of the Week



## Mincemeat Refrigerator Cookies

Temp.-375°, Time-About 15 min. Yield - 6 doz.

2½ cups sifted enriched all purpose flour,  
½ tsp. salt  
½ tsp. baking soda  
1 tsp. cinnamon  
1 cup granulated sugar  
¾ cup soft shortening  
1 egg  
½ tsp. vanilla extract  
½ cup mincemeat  
1 tsp. grated lemon rind  
½ cup chopped walnuts

Sift together first 4 ingredients. Mix, until creamy, sugar, shortening, egg, and extract. Mix in flour mixture alternately with mincemeat. Add lemon rind and nuts; mix. Shape, wrap, and chill as in Refrigerator Cookies. To bake: Heat oven. Slice dough ¼" thick. Place on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake till done.
