Marshmallow Refrigerator Pie

24 marshmallows ($\frac{1}{2}$ lb.) $\frac{1}{2}$ c. milk
Melt in top of double boiler, then cool.
Fold in:
 $\frac{1}{2}$ pt. whipped cream (1 c. before Whipping)
 $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. vanilla
Add fruit, well drained. (Crushed pineapple and fresh strawberries, or crushed pineapple and maraschino cherries.)

Crust:

10 graham crackers, crushed
2 tbsp. melted butter
Mix and press in pan. Reserve a little of the crumb mixture for the top. Chill in refrigerator. This can be made the day before as to be served.
