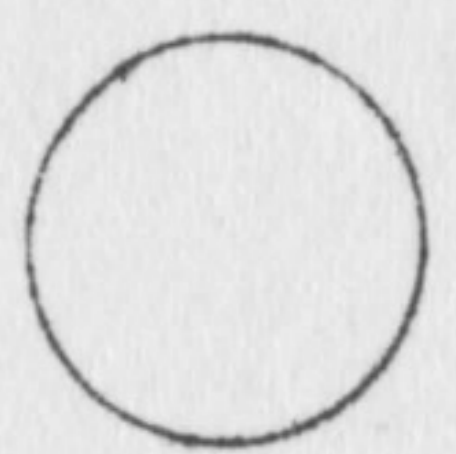

- Held large work party at Kiwanis Park, put in a new well and a pump.

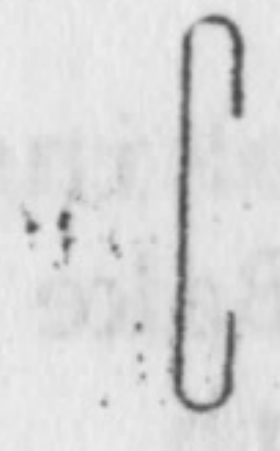
