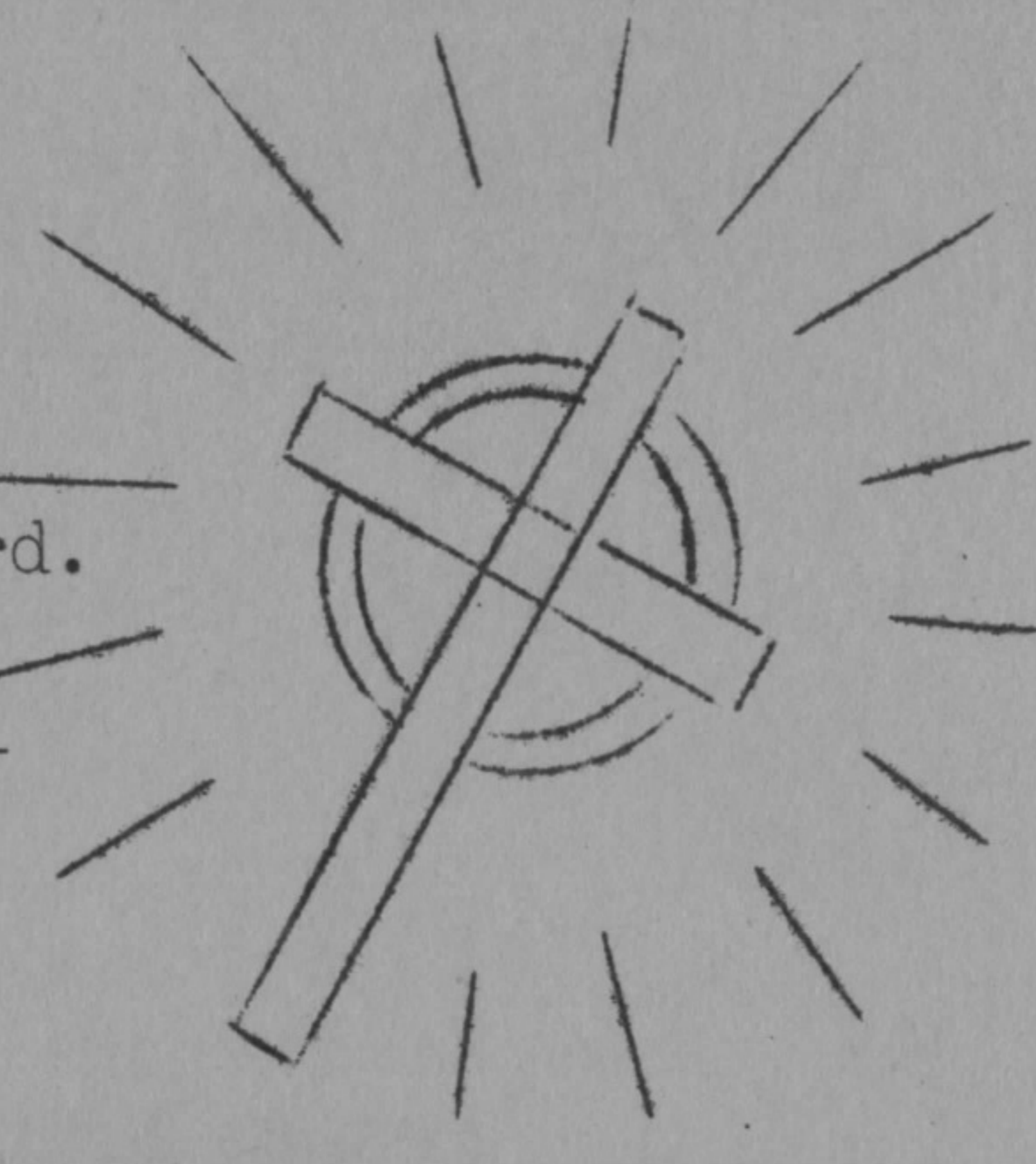
LIBRARY NEWS
