COCONUT BARS

- 1/2 cup soft butter
- 1 1/2 cup light-brown sugar, packed
- 1 1/4 cup sifted flour
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup chopped nuts
- 1 can (3 1/2 oz.) flaked coconut

Cream butter and 1/2 cup of the sugar. Add 1 cup of the flour, and mix well. Pat into greased 13 x 9 x 2 inch pan. Bake in 375°F. oven, 12 min. Mix remaining sugar, flour, and other ingredients. Spread evenly on mixture in pan. Bake 20 min. Cut in 54 bars. Store airtight, when cool.
