At the last General Election held June 10th, 1957, 82% of the Terrace Bay electorate turned out to vote. While this percentage was high enough to place us first in our constituency regarding percentage voted, it is not impossible to have a near 100% turnout, thus placing Terrace Bay in a position to win recognition as the town which provided the largest percentage turn-out in Canada!!

The right to vote is a privilege we should not take for granted. All of us should be sure to exercise our franchise and vote.
