Second prize in the second event went to the Van Koughnett rink of Schreiber, with 3rd prize to the Arthurs rink of Heron Bay South, and 4th prize to the Reith rink of Fort William.

The 3rd event was won by Betty Bouchard's rink of Terrace Bay, with Audrey Rowley 3rd, Louise Smith 2nd, and Evelyn Shivas, lead. The Bouchard rink was the only Terrace Bay rink out of 7 competing to survive the first two days of play. The Bouchard rink defeated the McArthur rink from Fort William to win 1st prize in the 3rd event. The McArthur rink took 2nd prize, with the Morin rink of Chapleau taking 3rd prize and the Cassidy rink of Fort William 4th prize.

With 23 rinks competing, composed of rinks from Fort William, Schreiber, Beardmore, Chapleau, Manitouwadge, Marathon, Heron Bay South, and Terrace Bay, the Bonspiel once again was a huge success.
