# TWO HUNDRED ACRE BUSH FIRE EAST OF TERRACE BAY ON THURSDAY MAY 15

Last Thursday, May 15 a bush fire started in the vicinity of Terrace Bay and due to a high wind spread rapidly in an easterly direction.

Due to the quick action this fire was held by 6 p.m. that night and was under control by Friday noon.

Some of the equipment used to fight this fire was as follows: 

18100 feet of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hose laid into the bush on the fire, 1000 feet of 21" hose laid from the . . CEMETERY BOALD NEWS fire truck to the fire, 4 forestry fire pumps, 4 motor boats, 40 pump cans, 1 plane which dropped water over the fire and staved off the fire until the wind died down. 160 gals. of water is carried in the pontoons on the plane.

There were about 125 men fighting the fire in relays of 65 to 70 men at a time.

Mr. McGooey, Department of Lands and Forests at Pays Flat and Mr. George Maitland Fire Chief of Terrace Bay wish to thank the men who fought this fire, especially on Thursday evening. Mr. McGooey also informed us that the restrictions made on bush travel at the time of the fire are now cancelled.
