CHLORINE DIOXIDE BLEACHERY (cont'd from P. 1)

An ancillary project is the necessary changes to existing seal boxes under the bleach washers. (Seal boxes take the "rinse" liquid from the stock being washed). This is a ninety-thousand dollar project which has commenced. Concrete and tile work will be done by contract. Otherwise this work will be done by our own crews.

Also in the Pulp Preparation Department a new Cowan Rotary Pulp Screen is being installed. It has been found necessary to increase the screening capacity in the Pulp Preparation Department.

The cost of this Rotary Pulp Screen is about **sixty-five thousand dollars**.
