S-A-F-E-T-Y RULES FOR GASOLINE

Did you read about the recent gasoline in explosion at the Lakehead? A boarder was cooking in his room with a gasoline stove. Gas vapour was escaping from it. When the vapour came in contact with the open element an explosion took place that actually jarred the walls of the house from its foundation.

Maximum amount of gas in the stove -- one pint.

A Lakehead Fire Chief stated it was fortunate that it was a frame house, otherwise the concussion would have done much more damage. -- Follow the safety rules for gasoline: -

SAFETY RULES FOR GASOLINE

1. Always remember that you must take no chances with gasoline; it is one of the most dangerous substances in common use.
2. It must always be kept in tightly fastened cans; never in glass bottles.
3. It should never be uncovered within the house, nor at any point where it's fumes can travel to an open flame.
4. Do not use it for cleaning; get a safe cleaning preparation.
5. Gasoline in quantity should be kept in underground tanks.
6. No one should be allowed to smoke in a Garage.
7. No one should be allowed to smoke in an automobile while it's gasoline tank is being filled.
