The Terrace Bay squad journeyed to the Lakehead for their 2nd road trip of the season and, as in all their doubleheaders previously, again emerged from the weekend's activities with another split. The results left the T.B.ers in an identical 3rd place tie with the westfort albions, as they trounced a weak Port Arthur Husky-Giant team 9-4 under the lights Saturday nite at the Stadium while dropping a close 4-2 encounter on Sunday to the Albions at McKellar Park. Saturday nite's game started out to be a real rout as the T.B.ers showed from the initial pitch that they were out to win. The 1st inning opened with Hanley reaching first on an error. Marvin Osmar walked and Moro loaded the bases as he got on with a fielder's choice. Hansen then singled in Hanley, and Maurice Osmar then singled in brother Marvin & Moro. This then finished Giant starter Prezic and brought in Ted Hanley to pitch. He promptly walked Petrie. Hansen then scored on an error as Stachiw got on first. LaSarge then singled in Maurice Osmar and Petrie and later Stachiw and LaSarge scored on errors. This thus gave the T.B.ers a healthy 8-0 Lead and proved to be all that was required. In the 2nd the lead was stretched to 9-0 as Moro walked and scored on an error.

This finished the Terrace scoring for the nite. However the giants scored one in the 3rd as Ted Hanley reached 1st on an error and scored on a sacrifice. The giants then scored their final 3 runs in the fifth as Allard reached first on an error and scored on an error. LeMay and Cava then singled and each scored on a fielder's choice and a sacrifice. This thus brought the scoring to an end in a well played contest before a crowd of 270 spectators.
