SUMMER PLAYGROUND

Summer playground activities for this season will commence on Monday, June 30th.

This year's programme will be run from the Ball Hut at the Public School grounds and will be handled as outlined below:

- 1) Ages: All children between the ages of 5 and 10 inclusive, are eligible to attend summer playground.
- 2) Periods: Children engaged in afternoon swimming lessons will attend playground during the mornings.  
- Children attending morning swimming classes will attend playground during the afternoons.
- 3) Days: Monday to Friday - 9 a.m. - 12:00  
1 p.m. - 5:00  
The playground will not function on weekends.
- 4) Activities: Arts, Crafts, Games, Hikes, Special Days, Storytelling, Sports,  
Variety Concert: Where the children produce a full-scale show for the benefit of the parents.  
Athletic Achievement Test: A set of physical tests which the children attempt to pass. This test has been set up to try to interest the children in keeping themselves physically fit. Those passing the tests receive awards. This will be covered more fully in letters to the parents.

The playground this year will be directed by Miss Norma Schock, who will be assisted by another local girl yet to be selected.
