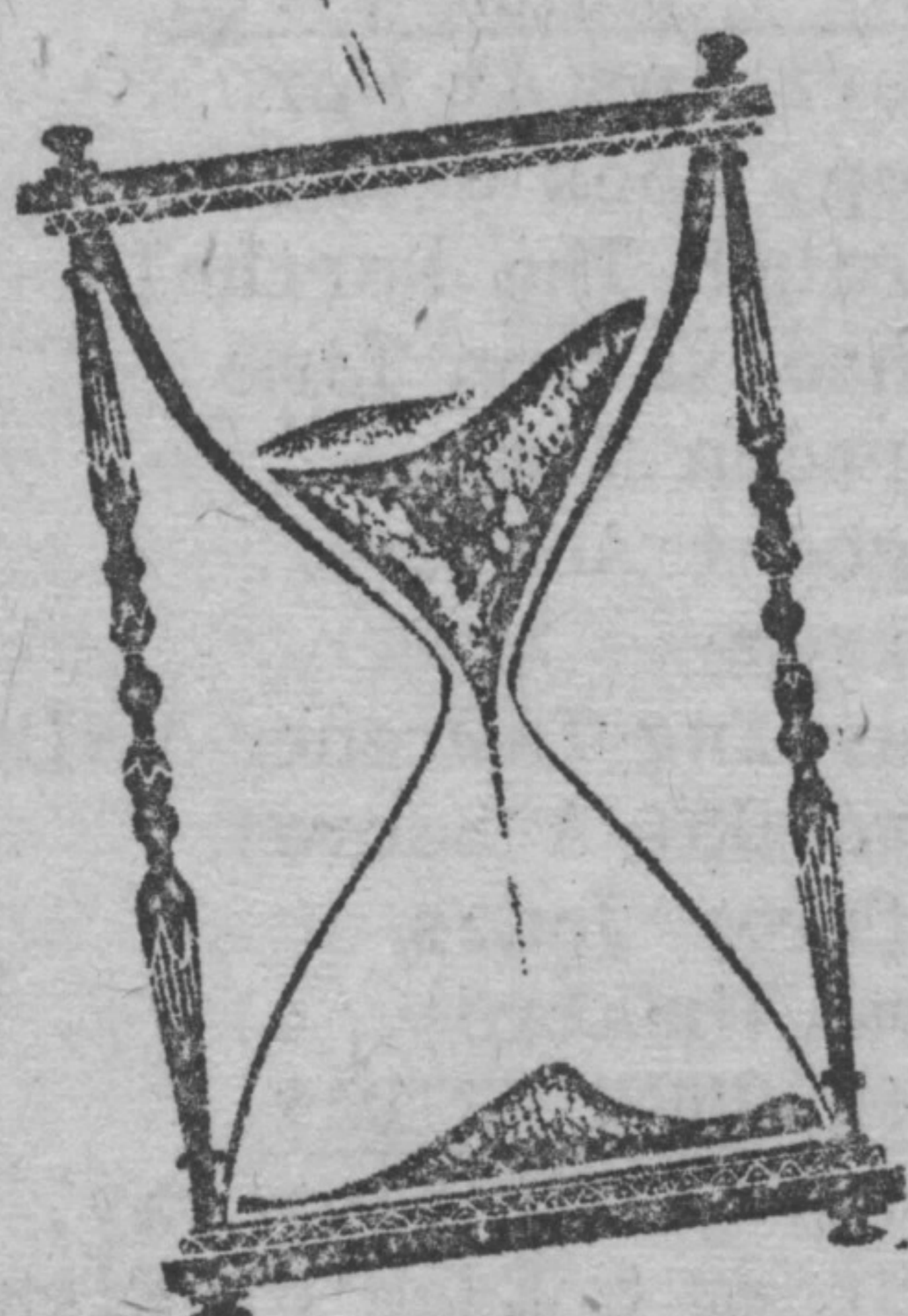
COMMUNITY CHURCH AUXILIARY MEET MONDAY
