**RE: DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE**

Numerous complaints against dogs running at large in town have been received by the Board of Trustees. These complaints are not restricted to any specific area but come from all sections of the town.

By-law 45A states that no person shall permit his or her dog to run at large in the Townsite of Terrace Bay except as follows:

1. When on a chain or lead accompanied by the owner or some other competent person.
2. Dogs may be permitted to run at large between the hours of 8:00 P.M. and 11:00 P.M. daily.

Offenders are subject to a fine for each infraction. This will be enforced by the Provincial Police Officers.

Any further complaints to the Board will be passed to the Police for action.
