By-law 45A states that no person shall permit his or her dog to run at large in the Townsite of Terrace Bay except as follows:

- 1. When on a chain or lead accompanied by the owner or some other competent person.
- Dogs may be permitted to run at large between the hours of 8:00 P.M. and 11:00 P.M. daily.

Offenders are subject to a fine for each infraction. This will be enforced by the Provincial Police Officers.

Any further complaints to the Board will be passed to the Police for action.
