TEENAGERS COMPLETE HUNTER SAFETY TRAINING

A class of 18 teenage boys recently completed a 12 hour course on hunter safety training, comprising classroom lectures, a written

examination and a field test including the firing of live ammunition.

This course being the second held so far, is sponsored locally by the Terrace Bay Fish & Game Association for the purpose of giving instruction in safe hunting techniques and to encourage the care in handling of guns that can eliminate a large percentage of accidents in the field and home.

The course stresses the points of proper gun handling in circumstances related to hunting and basic information about guns and ammunition. Sportsmanship and conservation are also stressed because safe hunting and sportsmanship go hand in hand.

The Club's chief instructor, Gordon Kydd, was assisted by E.Persson, C.Haviland, N.Coan, T.Delaronde, G.Burns and Stan Hodgkiss, with a special thank you to Capt.J.Jeanneret of the local L.S.S.R. unit who supervised the rifle range practice.
