CIGARETTES CAUSE TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF FIRES Cigarettes (matches -- smoking, that is)

cause about a fourth of the nation's fires. Why? How?

Every year, the Fire Chiefs estimate about 400 billion cigarettes are smoked-about 800,000 a minute. At that rate, it takes only one cigarette in 2,000,000 to cause 200,000 fires a year. If you are a cigarette smoker, the best course to follow is to regard every one you light as the one in two million that may cause a fire.
