**NEW DISTRIBUTION METHOD FOR TERRACE BAY NEWS**

We have been abruptly informed by the Post Office Department in Ottawa that this paper will no longer be allowed 2nd Class mailing privileges. Second class mail rates are as follows: 1¢ for the first two ounces, 1¢ for the next two ounces and 1¢ for each additional four ounces.

These rates have made it possible for us to distribute the paper through the Post Office in Terrace Bay and Schreiber at no cost to the individual residents. However, the Post Office Department now inform us that we must pay 1½ cents a copy for each copy delivered through the Post Office and 2¢ per copy if the paper is mailed directly to a subscriber. This cost of postage makes it prohibitive for us to continue to distribute the paper through the Post Office.

We will, therefore, have the paper delivered to each house in Terrace Bay, and to the North Camp, Hotel and Hospital. The paper will be delivered by school boys and, for the most part, will be delivered on Wednesday after 4 P.M.

We will place a "Take One" News Box in Schreiber which will be located in front of the Town Hall. Ample copies of the News will be in this box in Schreiber on Thursday morning. (This system in Schreiber will probably begin on Thursday, March 31st).

Some people have indicated they would still like to receive the News personally addressed to them and are prepared to pay the cost of the postage and handling. The cost of postage in this case will be 2¢ per copy. If anyone in Terrace Bay, Schreiber, Rosspoint, etc. is interested in receiving a copy of the News in this manner we will charge \$2.00 per year. This sum will have to be paid in advance at the News Office in Terrace Bay (Post Office Basement) on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, or a cheque or Money Order may be sent to the Terrace Bay News, Box 579, Terrace Bay, Ont.
