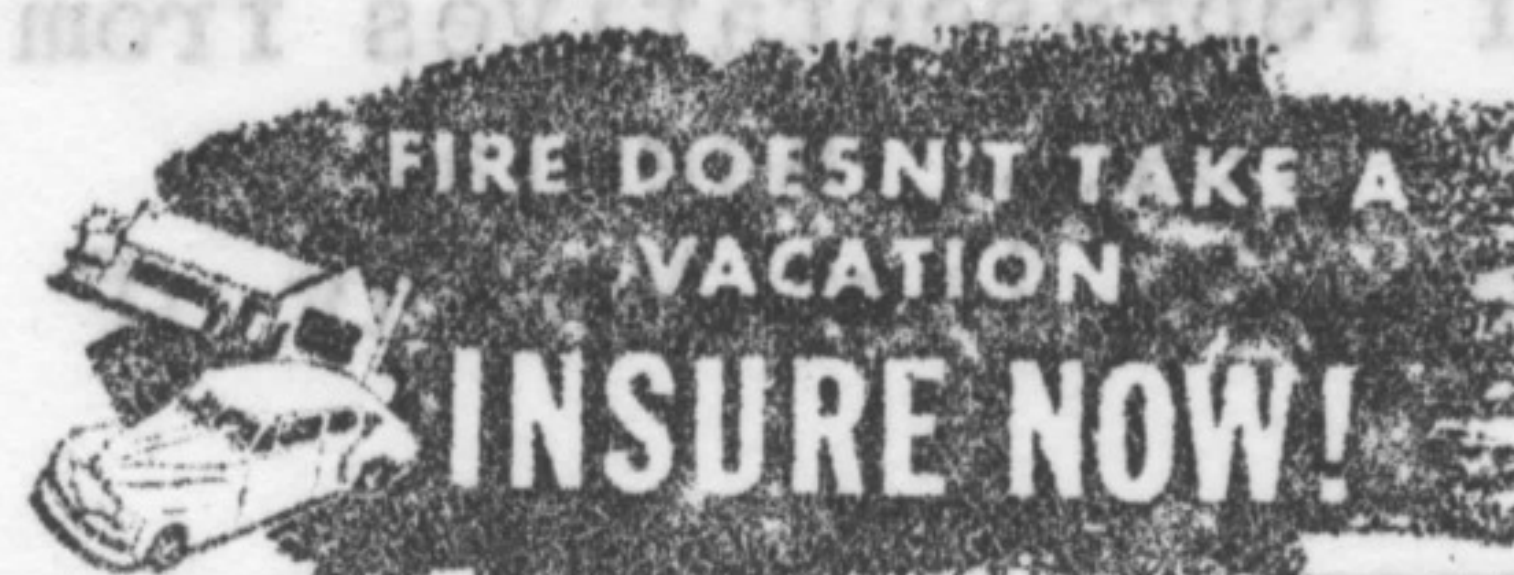
LEASE OF CROWN LAND
