Miss Ruth Madigan of Chapleau was the weekend guest of Miss Glorie Gordon.

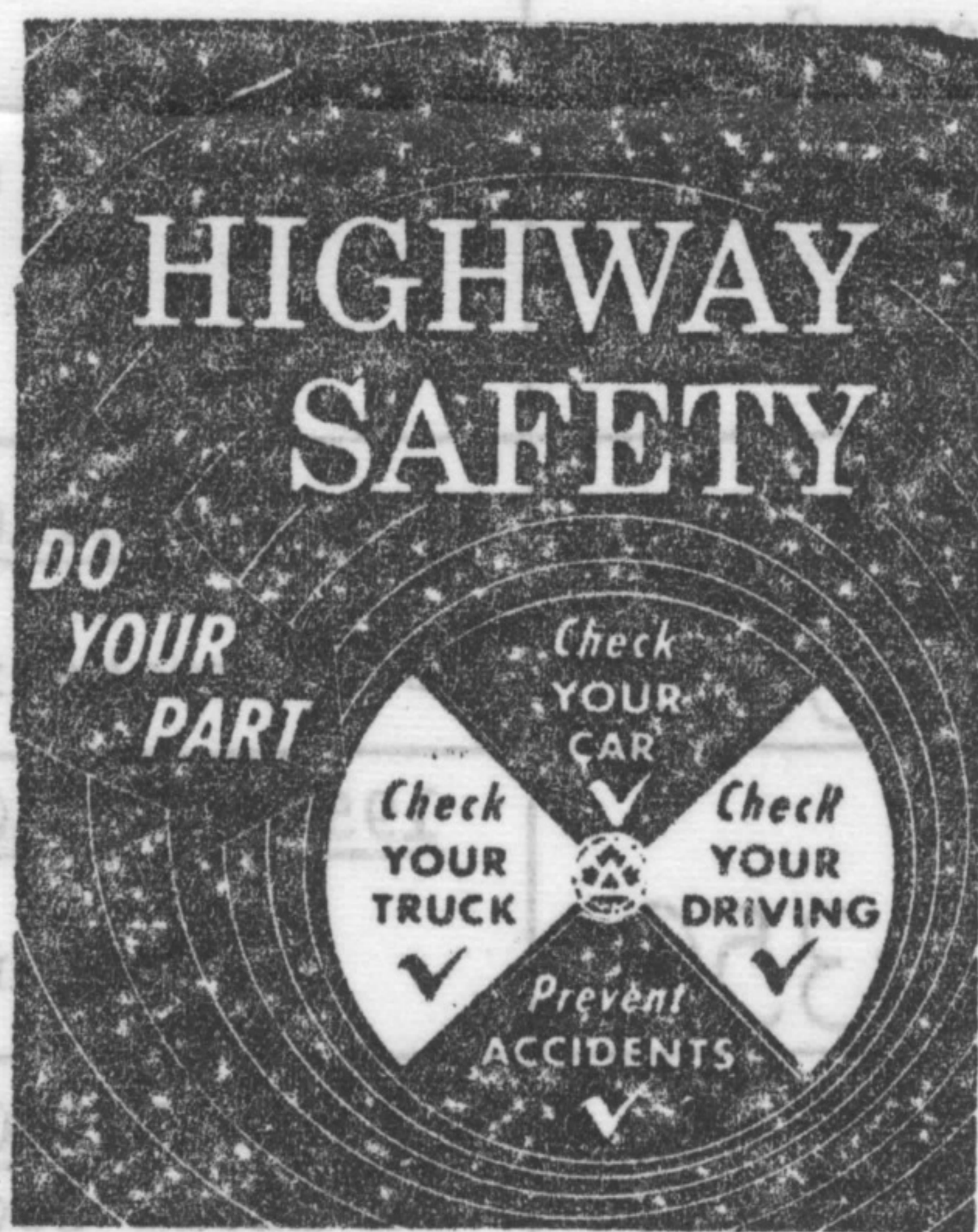
